

Logwin at the Dynea industrial park in Krems: experience chemicals logistics live!

Grevenmacher (Luxembourg) - On the occasion of the fourth Open Day at the Dynea industrial park in Krems on 26 September Logwin took a positive stock: over the last few months the logistics service provider has invested in new equipment and extended its service in the area of chemicals logistics.

The eight companies at the Dynea industrial park in Krems open their doors to the public every two years. Following its change of name to Quehenberger in 2006, Logochem, the leading logistics partner for the chemicals companies located here, presented itself under the new Logwin brand for the first time: all companies in the Logwin Group in Austria, Germany, Switzerland, Belgium, Liechtenstein, Luxembourg and the Netherlands changed their name to Logwin as of 1 July. In Austria this involved the renaming of among others Birkart, Delacher, Nunner, Quehenberger and Welz. At the same time the Quehenberger subsidiary Logochem at the Bergheim, Krems, Linz, and Vienna locations also changed its name to Logwin.

Seamless scanning for major customer Dynea

Logwin did not just introduce itself at Krems with its new name but also presented new equipment and services: at the beginning of January the logistics service provider implemented barcode scanning in a joint project with its long-established major customer Dynea. Dynea is a global leader in the manufacture of high-quality synthetic resins and adhesives for the wood processing and construction industries. The customised barcode labels enable the companies to create seamless transparency through the entire supply chain. "We have realised an optimal on-site process chain for Dynea", explains Reinhold Pölzl, Managing Director Industrial Goods at the Logwin business segment Solutions. "Thanks to barcode scanning our customer can track the path of any package virtually in real time, and with this tried and tested technology we always keep an eye on the current volumes increase as well."

Rail transport - a popular alternative

Rail freight transportation is showing a positive trend: Logwin has invested in an additional two-way vehicle. There are three of these vehicles available now to shunt waggons around the site. "The railway siding and the vicinity to the port allow us to combine all carriers at the Krems location - truck, barge or railway waggon" says Reinhold Pölzl. It is particularly in the area of rail transport that Logwin is experiencing increased transport volumes. "Rail is a welcome alternative in times of high energy prices and expensive legal restrictions", explains Pölzl. At the same time, the demand for transportation is increasing due to increasing shipment

volumes, especially in connection with the production of biodiesel: Logwin provides Austrian customers with around 200,000 tonnes of raw materials for biodiesel production each year. The service portfolio ranges from the procurement of raw materials through to the collection of biodiesel from the plant concerned.
