Due to the loss and destruction of their habitats, for example as a result of land use, urbanization or climate change, many of these unique creatures are coming under increasing pressure.

Expressive photographs, all taken by Senckenberg researchers on their travels, show these rare species in their natural habitats and are supplemented by concise background information from Senckenberg research. This creates an impressive overall picture: fascinating in appearance, vulnerable in terms of population and absolutely worthy of protection.

The images in this calendar will spark conversation in offices, break rooms, conference rooms and classrooms. 'One of a Kind' inspires and invites reflection on the value of diversity and the opportunities offered by shared global solutions.
