

Coming together to make more happen: Logwin plans German-wide day of action for families in cooperation with Save the Children

Grevenmacher/Großostheim – Being socially engaged and taking corporate responsibility is part of a Logwin corporate culture that spans all areas of the company. The family day of action is to take place on the International Children's Day on 18/19 November in all Logwin's German branches. Last year, Logwin actively supported Save the Children with a donation and aid transport. With this new project, the company is extending its cooperation with the international aid organisation who uphold the rights of children.
